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each year for photographers and wildlife viewing. If your interest is fishing for trophy rainbow trout, battling explosive pacific salmon fresh from the sea or tangling with feisty arctic char we have the expertise and experience to make your Alaska dreams come true. Share your dreams with us and we will guide you toward the type of expedition that best matches your expectations.

Started in 1993 Alaska Rainbow Adventures is owned and operated by Alaska resident Paul Hansen who has been tossing a line, pitching tents, manning the oars, paddle or throttle for himself and the pleasure of others here in Alaska since 1979. Our regular staff of guides reside and earn their living here as well, and bring to the river that unique local knowledge of fishing Alaska you can only get as a resident of the 49<sup>th</sup> state.



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Your wake-up call every morning is 7:00 am with hot coffee or favorite beverage delivered to your tent. Breakfast is at 7:30 am. After breakfast, you will have time to go back to your tent to pack up your bags, fold up your sleep tent and take your gear down to rafts. The rafts are then loaded and we start floating around 9:00 am. We spend the morning float/fishing until lunchtime. After lunch, we continue float/fishing to our evening campsite arriving about 5:30 pm. After the rafts have been unloaded, the guides will begin to set up camp. Your next decision is whether to sit back and just relax or continue fishing the camp waters. It generally takes an hour for the camp to be up and ready. Appetizers are ready around 6:30pm and supper at 7:30 pm. After supper, you can wade fish the camp waters until you are satisfied



### Rafts

On our deluxe trips we use either state of the art 18' catarafts or 14' self bailing rafts from the largest producer of whitewater craft in America to get you safely down the river in comfort. Each raft is equipped with a custom rowing frame, floor, and for angler comfort, padded high back seats. For our intimate rivers program, trips where access may be difficult or the 18' boats are just too big we utilize the 14' self bailing rafts, however all of these provide a safe, comfortable platform for fishing and relaxing while drifting downstream in search of what action awaits around the next bend. Togiak River trips will be outfitted with 14' self bailing rafts, up to three guests and one guide per boat as per our permit from the US Fish and Wildlife Service.

Options for a Cargo Boat and extra hand setting up camp are available on some rivers at additional cost.

### Accommodations

Accommodations on the deluxe river trips are in spacious, high quality four to six-person tents. Each of these tents is used to house two anglers. This provides you ample space for your gear, as well as a comfortable retreat should the weather become inclement. These tents make getting ready in the morning a breeze, allowing you to stand comfortably while gearing up and putting on waders. We also provide cots and sleeping pads, a welcome luxury after a day of fishing. Each campsite will have a designated area away from camp, with the private toilet unit that is required under the auspices of our federal permit. Please note that our Intimate rivers trips use smaller 4 man tents and offer a few less of the deluxe comforts depending on what we can safely carry in aircraft and on the rafts.

### Meals

Meals are served home style and offer generous portions of traditional entrees prepared with choice cuts of meat and fresh fish. At midday, a hearty lunch is prepared on the bank, and should you need an extra bit of energy to help you land that big one, snacks are available. You are invited to make menu suggestions for your trip and we will try to accommodate them whenever possible. We recommend you drink only filtered water, which we will provide throughout the trip.

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## TRIP DETAILS

Season	June 8 to late September
Fish Species:	Rainbow Trout, all five species pacific salmon arctic char and grayling
Tackle:	4 to 10weight rod with floating and sink tip lines appropriate depending on species.
Clothing:	A layered approach of synthetic materials polypro underwear to fleece wind stopper jacket and good quality raingear. Breathable waders are considered best with felt soled wading shoes, polarized sunglasses a must complete suggested list will be supplied.
Rate:	3,295 to 4,995 depending on type of trip (deluxe or intimate rivers programs), river and length of trip chosen.
Package Includes:	Seven days six nights accommodations, Six and a half days guided fishing Round trip floatplane flights from departure point. All meals and beverages (coffee, tea, water and juice)
Capacity:	Six anglers, larger groups traveling together can be accommodated call for details.
Getting There:	Trips start in either King Salmon or Dillingham Alaska depending on which trip you choose. We are happy to recommend a travel agent with Alaska travel experience should you require it.
